- 2.Netspend is a corporation located at P.O. Box 2136 Austin,TX 78768-2136.

COUNT ONE :NEGLIENCE

- 1.Netspend violated the 2007 gambling enforcement act of 2007 by putting through gambling transactions totaling \$15,500 on the plaintiff's credit card.
- 2.Netspend refunded \$7500.00 of these transactions.
- 3.Netspend is negligent in not refunding the other \$8000.00 to the plaintiff.The money is owed to him and all paperwork was filed on time by the plaintiff to refund these gambling transactions to him.
- 4.Netspend violated chapter 93 a of the Massachusetts general laws by not giving the plaintiff the consumer these funds back.
